Grocery Club Card Power Registration:

Enclosed in last week's Wednesday envelope was a one-page eScrip Grocery Club Card Power Registration Log. Power registration enables us to expand our school's supporter base. We encourage you to gather as many new supporters as possible to increase our eScrip contributions. There is a minimum amount of information required on the form, it's an easy way to collect Club Card numbers from family members, friends, neighbors, coworkers, etc.

It is not unusual for someone to happily give you their Club Card Number, but refuse to provide their name, address, email address, etc. This is fine. We can still register them, with just the Club Card type and number. To ensure that your family gets credit towards your financial agreement, make sure that YOU (parent/guardian) fill out your name below under "Form Completed By". Simply fill in the required info on the form, and return the form to the school office, Attn: Camille Inyang, eScrip Coordinator. There is no deadline, as Power Registration is an ongoing process.
