Extended Care:

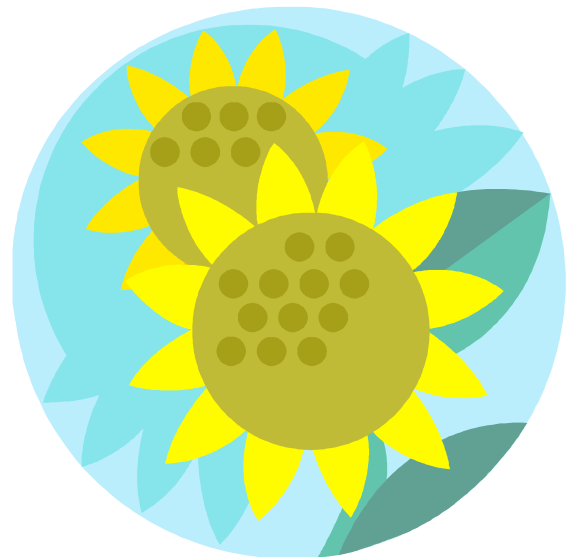
